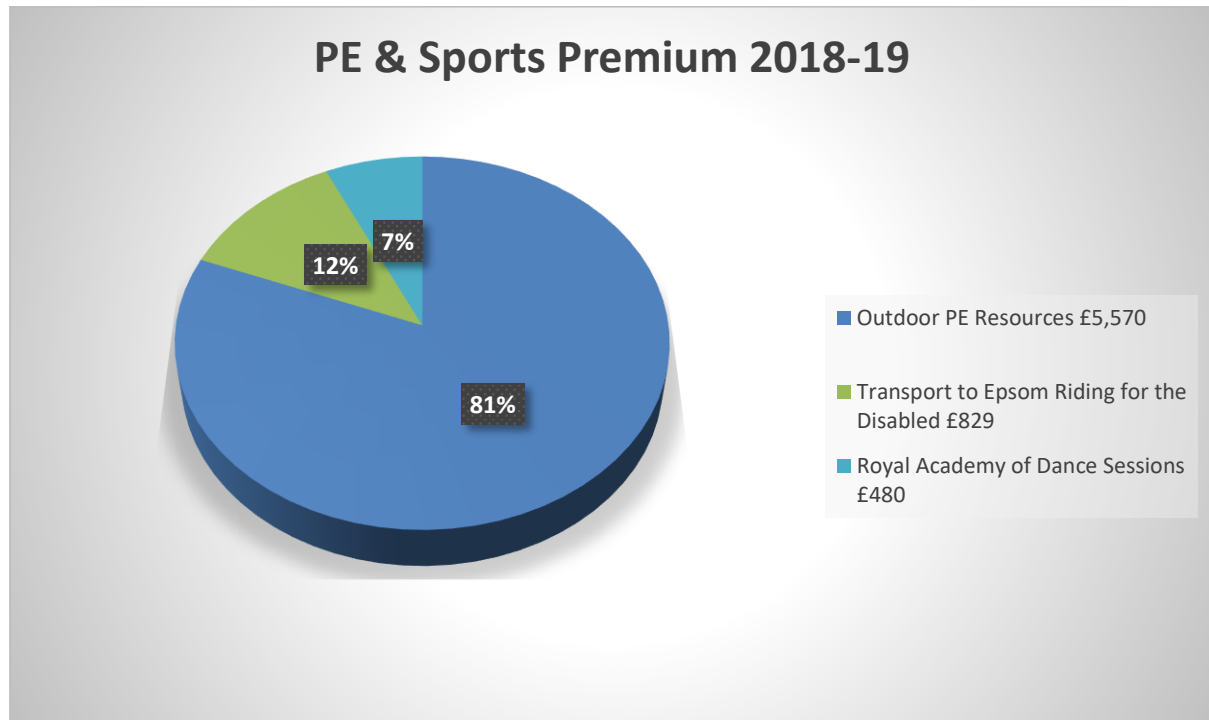


## PE and Sport Premium at Greenmead Primary School 2018-19

The PE and Sport Premium is additional government funding to improve the quality of PE and sports activities offered to pupils in school. This is a challenging concept for Greenmead as many of the children do not undertake conventional 'PE'. The funding is allocated in two amounts. The first amount is given for 1<sup>st</sup> April 2018 to 31<sup>st</sup> August 2018 and was £6,879. The next amount which has not yet been received will be for the period 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019.

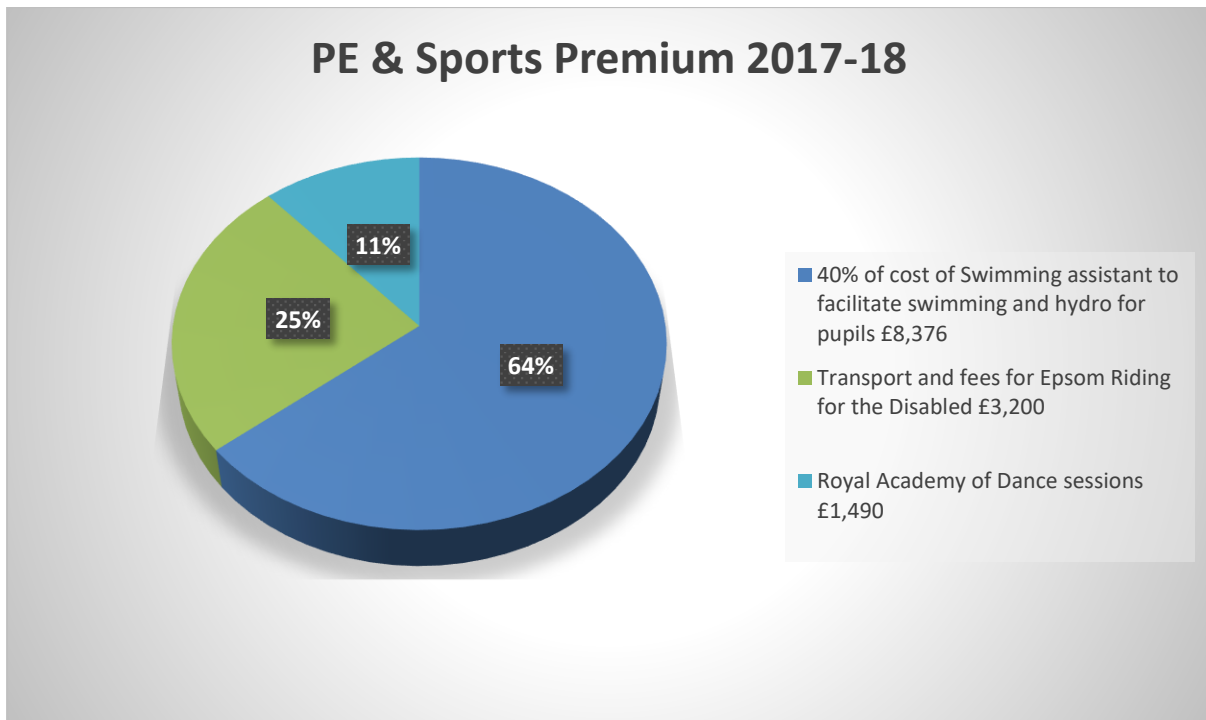


- Purchase of 13 piece gym set, a wooden step bridge, wooden tunnel, rainbow den and climb hill. These items will encourage the children to explore improve their physical development and balance outdoors
- Transport and fees to the Epsom Riding for the Disabled Centre for 4 pupils for weekly riding sessions for Autumn Term 2018
- Royal Academy of Dance weekly sessions conducted by a teacher for Autumn Term 2018

## How last year's PE and Sports Premium was spent!

The total funding for the financial year 2017-18 was £13,066.



## How the PE & Sports Premium made a difference to the participation of pupils in physical activity at Greenmead School.

- A 40% contribution to the cost of support staff to facilitate swimming and hydro for each class
- Transport and fees to the Epsom Riding for the Disabled Centre for 4 pupils for weekly riding sessions
- Royal Academy of Dance weekly sessions conducted by a dance teacher for all the classes in the school
