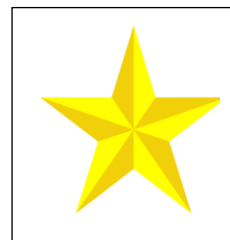

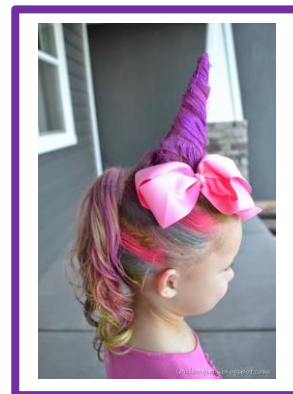

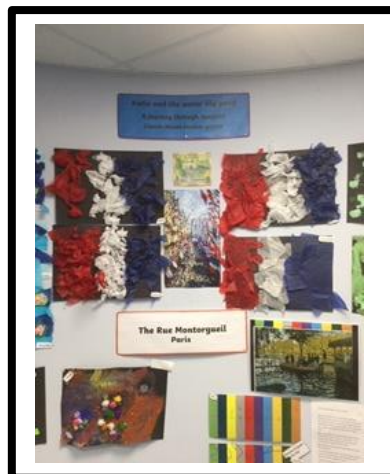


Curriculum Themes for Spring 2
