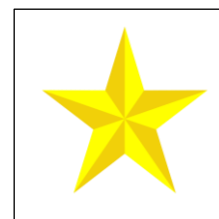


Achievement Awards this week ...

Speech and Language Therapy & Parent/Carer Network

On **April 3rd from 12-2pm** the Speech and Language Therapy team will holding a Parent/Carer Network meeting.

This network was the idea of a Greenmead parent who found something very similar through a Facebook support page. Several sessions were held last academic year and were felt to be a great opportunity to offer support to Greenmead families, as well as creating social opportunities for yourselves and your children.

The idea of the group is to link up termly with a therapist around a particular topic/strategy. The group then take this information home, see what works and what doesn't, and then meet up outside of school to discuss. These follow up Parent/Carer groups would be arranged amongst yourselves, so you could find a location and time that suits you all. We would like all link back up together in school, with the Therapy team the following half term, to trouble shoot and talk about other needs/interests.

School Meal Prices

You should have all received a letter regarding the changes to the school meal prices from the 1st of April 2019.

There will be an increase of £0.10 per day, making the daily cost £2.20 and the weekly cost for school lunches £11.00.

If you think your child may be entitled to free school meals and you need another application form please contact the school office and one will be sent home to you.

It is important that you apply for free school meals even if your child does not eat orally as the school currently receives a Pupil Premium grant for all eligible children.
