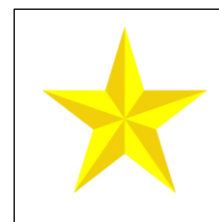


Achievement Awards this week ...

Wheelchair Repairs

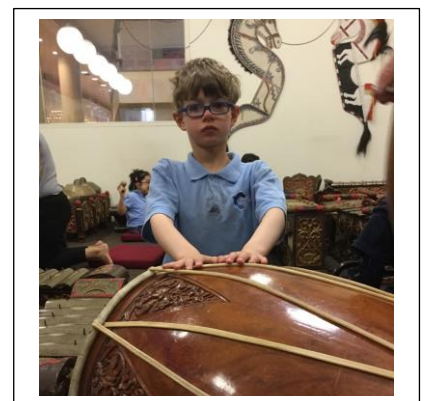
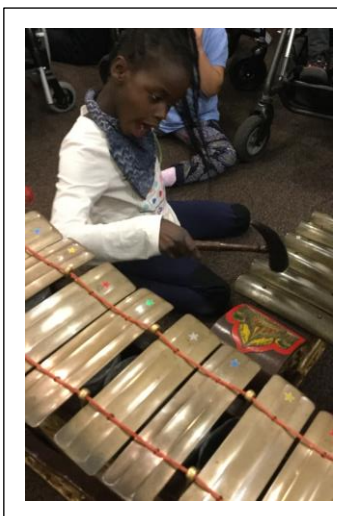
For those who have children that use a wheelchair, we would like to clarify the current repair process to make it easier and more streamlined. Mary from Roehampton Wheelchair Services will continue to run a termly wheelchair clinic at the school to review children and make adjustments to their wheelchair relating to growth and postural management as needed. If your child's wheelchair requires a repair, please contact the local AJM on 0208 641 6173, who will be able to respond to both minor and major needs. This AJM covers all children who are registered with GPs in Wandsworth, Richmond, Kingston, Spelthorne, Merton and Sutton. If you and your child live outside of these boroughs, local AJM numbers are as follows:

- Hounslow - NRS Mobility care, 0208 630 3994

Greenmead are happy to accommodate AJM appointments within school, but ask that parents request AJM call the school to book the appointment, to ensure children are not out on trips or away. If a child's wheelchair requires an emergency repair that becomes apparent once a child has arrived to school, Greenmead will contact AJM directly to come out as a priority and inform parents.
