


Achievement Awards this week ...

Parking on the school site

There have been some issues at the start and end of the day in the small car park at the front of school.

These include parents parking for long periods of time and waiting for their children to be collected, therefore not allowing others to park. Sometimes we have to call an ambulance for one of the children, and we need to have space for the ambulance to enter the car park area, or to be able to leave unhindered should the need arise. This is a very real concern for Greenmead staff.

We would like to trial making the library area a holding point for pupils so that parents can drive in from 9am and again at 3.20pm, to drop their children and leave, therefore allowing other parents to do the same. This means that parents do not wait around in the reception area. It means that more parents can use this facility, so they don't have to park on the road too far away. Parents must leave as soon as they have dropped their children. If you wish to stay to meet with a teacher or another member of staff you must leave the car park area and find an alternative parking space on the road. Alternatively, you can make an appointment for a convenient time for both the teacher and the parent.

A rota will be devised for staff to look after the children at the start and end of each day. Staff will be available from 9am to look after your child in the library area until 9.15am when they will be taken to their classes. At the end of the day staff will bring the children down as normal and leave those to be collected by parents in the library area with additional staff on hand to support.

This arrangement will be trialled from Monday 10th June 2019, for the rest of June initially. If you would like to give feedback it would be welcomed!
