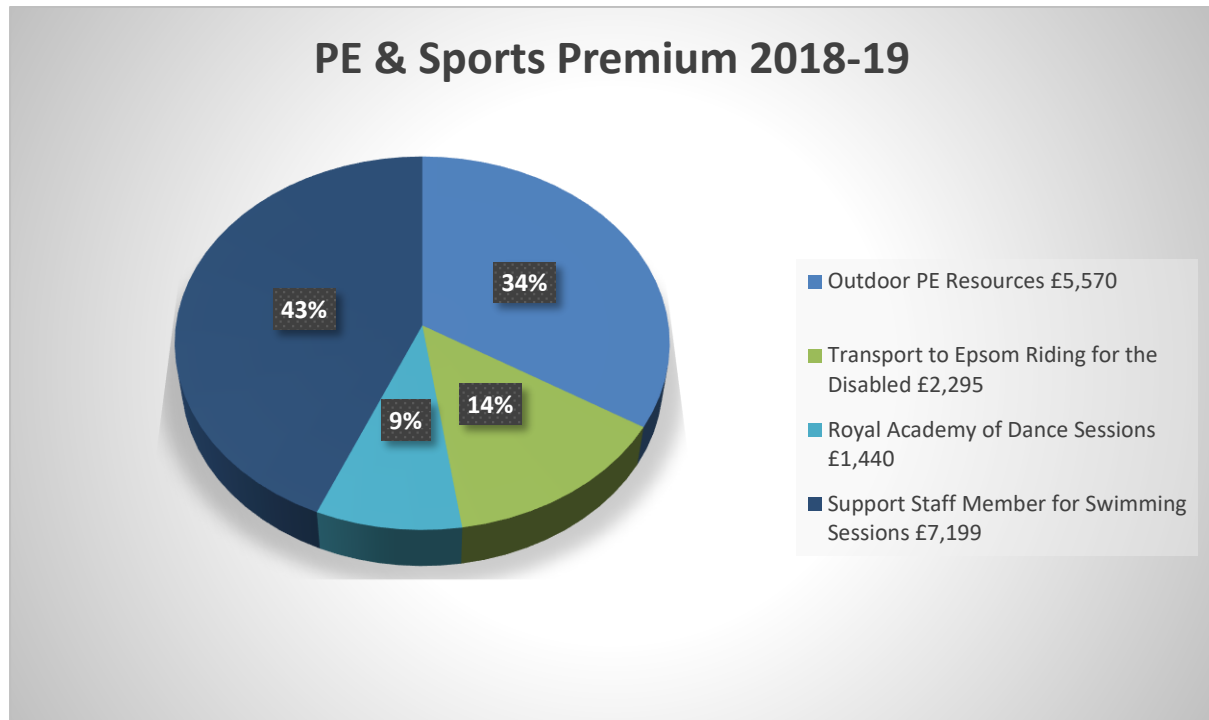


PE and Sport Premium at Greenmead Primary School 2018-19

The PE and Sport Premium is additional government funding to improve the quality of PE and sports activities offered to pupils in school. This is a challenging concept for Greenmead as many of the children do not undertake conventional 'PE'. The total funding for 1st April 2018 to 31st March 2019 was £16,504.



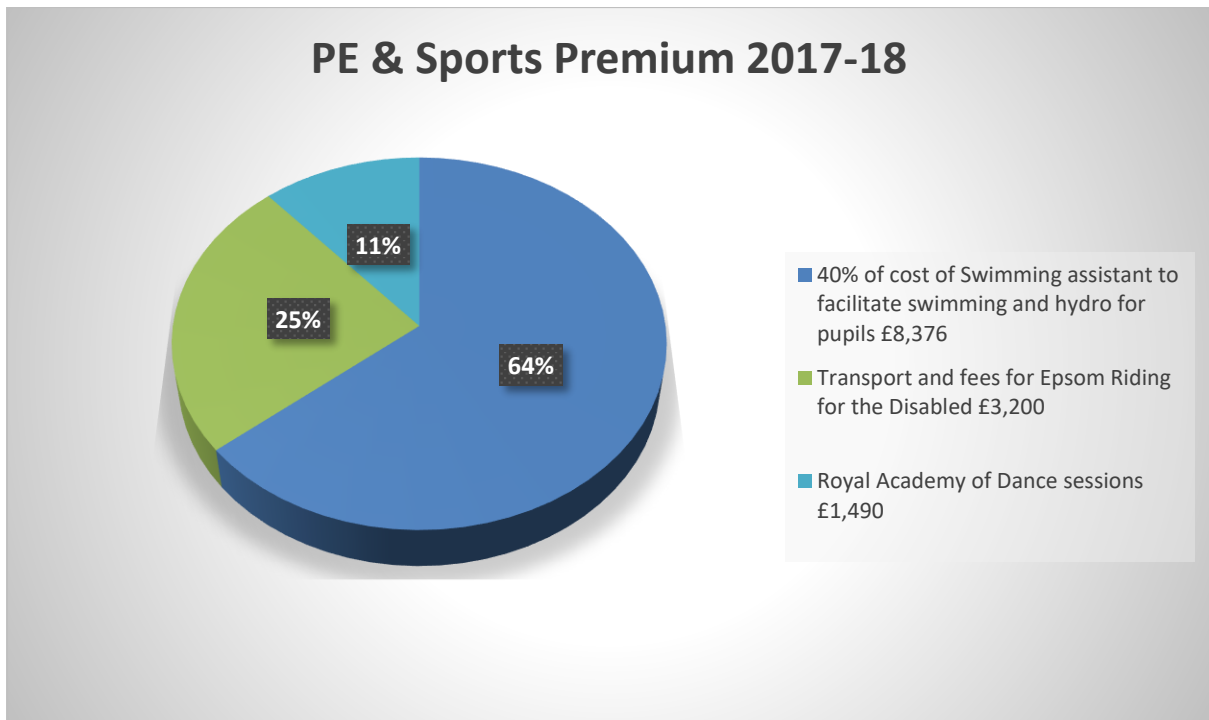
- Purchase of 13 piece gym set, a wooden step bridge, wooden tunnel, rainbow den and climb hill. These items will encourage the children to explore improve their physical development and balance outdoors
- Transport and fees to the Epsom Riding for the Disabled Centre for 4 pupils for weekly riding sessions for Autumn Term 2018
- Royal Academy of Dance weekly sessions conducted by a teacher for Autumn Term 2018
- A 40% contribution to the cost of support staff to facilitate swimming and hydro for each class

This funding means that every pupil in the school will be able to access some kind of physical activity during the school year.

The next review of PE and Sports Premium will be 24th May 2019.

How last year's PE and Sports Premium was spent!

The total funding for the financial year 2017-18 was £13,066.



How the PE & Sports Premium made a difference to the participation of pupils in physical activity at Greenmead School.
