Safeguarding children and young people

Safeguarding It is everyone's responsibility to

safeguard and promote the welfare of children and young people. You should always report your concerns, even if the person you suspect to be abusing or neglecting a child or young person is someone you know well

If you are being abused or are worried that a child or young person is at risk of being abused or neglected you should contact:

- Initial Point of Contant (IPOC) on 020 8871 6622. After 5pm on weekdays or at weekends call 020 8871 6000.
- In an emergency contact the Police on 999

*The WAND Card and WAND+ Card: These handy ID cards are for 0-24s living in Wandsworth, whose disability or special need severely impacts on their ability to get out and about. The cards are free and can be applied for alongside membership of the Disabled Children's Register.
