Please write out what you want them to google and allow them to type if possible.








Assembly will happen on Fridays at 3pm. Keep an eye out on the Instagram during the week for the theme and things you can bring to join in.







'Every Achievement Counts'

Formal Pathway:

Communication, Phonics and Reading

We will be providing reading books over the half term.

For children that are 'Emerging Readers' they will continue to work on building sentences to comment on books with their communication supports.

For our 'Early Readers' they will continue to use their phonics and any known red/sight words when reading the books provided. Please model and support them with this.

'Developing Readers' will continue to use their reading skills to read the stories and answer questions about what happened in them.

We will also send home a book for parents to read with their parents.

We will also be sending some simple phonics activities to practice skills in blending sounds. Please also use the appropriate phonics videos on the Youtube channel.

Writing For a Purpose: This half term we are learning about how to gain information. This will be through asking questions but also beginning to use the internet to search for answers!


Mathematics

Addition: Can we add 2 numbers together and get something bigger? Can we use our numbers and signs to write a sum?


We will also be sending some number poems for you to read together at home and see numbers in action!
