KC	Typing her name independently on the keyboard

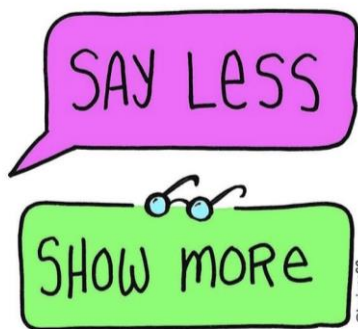
Christmas Shoebox Appeal
