## Formal Curriculum

### Areas of learning covered include:

**Communication, Phonics and Reading:** Understanding Literature, Recording, Writing for a Purpose, Phonics and Reading + Communication IEPs

**Mathematics and Cognition:** Maths (Number, Measurement, Geometry), Problem Solving Skills + Cognition IEPs

**SEMH/PSED:** Zones of Regulation, Eating and Drinking, Self-Care + SEMH IEPs

**Topic:** Half Termly Focus on Art + Design, History, Geography, Music, Science or an author study

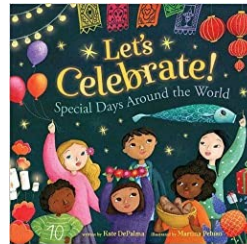
**Physical Development:** PE + Gross Motor/Fine Motor IEPs

### Communication, Phonics and Reading

Our Topic Book for this half term is 'Let's Celebrate' which is a rhyming book all about different festivals. We will also use factual books and cultural stories that tell us more about the festivals we are learning about.

We will be focussing this half term on writing cards and letters. Why and when to we send them? What do we need to include? How do we make sure it gets to the person? We will be starting up a pen pals scheme with Ronald Ross for this half term too!

We will continue with phonics and learning to apply our phonetic knowledge and reading high frequency words.



### Mathematics

We worked really hard on our counting last term and we are now ready to use our numbers for sums! We will be looking at the signs and symbols used in writing sums and what they can show.

In our wider curriculum we are going to explore 2D and 3D shapes and pattern.

### Topic: Creative Development

This term, our topic is linked to creative development. We will be making lots of lovely items that link to the festivals we are learning about. We will use a variety of tools, materials and plan and talk about what we make.
