


PE and Sport Premium at Greenmead Primary School 2020-21

The PE and Sport Premium is additional government funding to improve the quality of PE and sports activities offered to pupils in school. This is a challenging concept for Greenmead as many of the pupils do not undertake conventional PE but the school wants every child to experience some form of physical activity during the school year. The total funding for 1st April 2020 to 31st March 2021 is calculated on pupil numbers and the confirmed amount is £16,407.




Summary

- A 68% contribution to the cost of a support staff employee to facilitate swimming means every pupil has access to weekly swimming session which has been very well received by parents and governors
- The Royal Academy of Dance deliver weekly dance sessions through their Radiate Dance Project. This is currently taking place virtually due to Covid-19 restrictions and in line with our Covid risk assessment.
- We have also set aside some of this grant to be able to keep resources fresh, accessible and up to date for pupils to use during their physical development/PE sessions.

The next review of PE and Sports Premium will be 25th June 2021, following receipt of the new budget.

How last year's PE and Sports Premium was spent.

The total funding for the financial year 2019-20 was £16,500.



- Transport and fees to the Epsom Riding for the Disabled Centred for 4 pupils for weekly riding sessions for Summer Term 2019. Senior leaders and governors made the decision to stop these sessions so that the money could be spent on physical development sessions that a wider range of pupils can access.
- Royal Academy of Dance weekly sessions conducted by a teacher for the year 2019-20
- A 75% contribution to the cost of a support staff employee to facilitate swimming and hydro for each class

The funding enabled every pupil in the school to be able to access some kind of physical activity during the school year.
