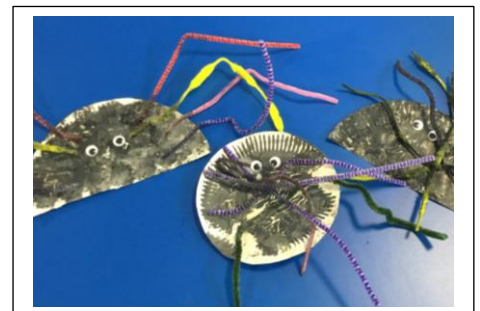
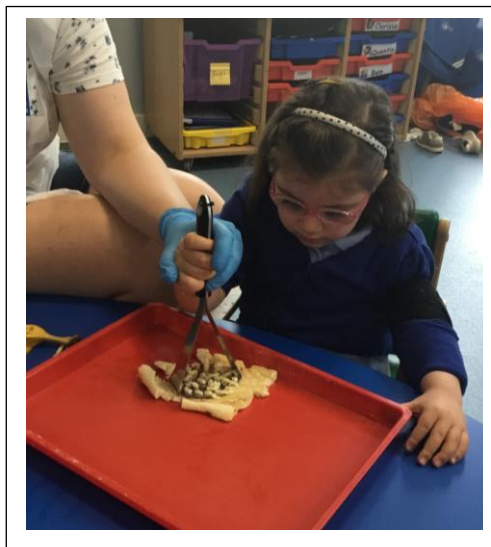

Covid Update

We've seen a rising number of pupils and staff in school showing possible Covid symptoms over the last week. This is coupled with rising positive cases across Wandsworth.

Thank you to everyone for staying at home if you or anyone in your household does have symptoms and getting a PCR test so that we can continue to keep school as safe as possible and avoid bubbles closing. Thankfully, test results are coming back as negative but we want to be absolutely sure.

In order to further promote infection control for the next three weeks we are going to temporarily suspend pupils in pathway bubbles mixing until the end of term. This will allow us to keep a careful track of contacts and avoid any class closures. We will, however, continue to have staff moving between their pathway bubbles to support as necessary which also helps to keep classes open. We can keep a tighter control of contacts when staff move classes.
