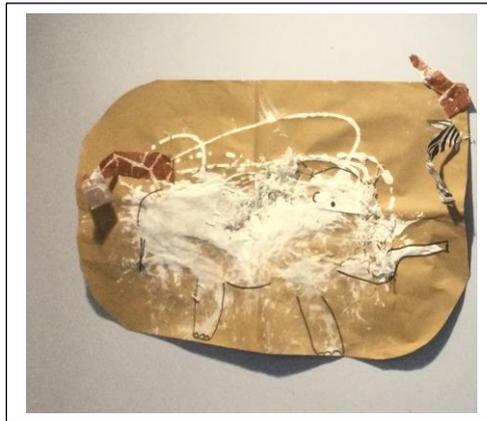
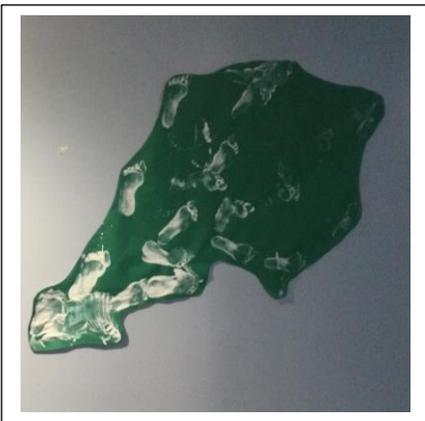
Shout-out to those pupils in Mars class who had to do home learning after a partial closure on Tuesday and Wednesday this week.

Covid Risk Assessment Update

An updated risk assessment was emailed to all parents/carers on Wednesday. Please do read through this with particular attention to isolation times and what to do if you test positive on a lateral flow test.

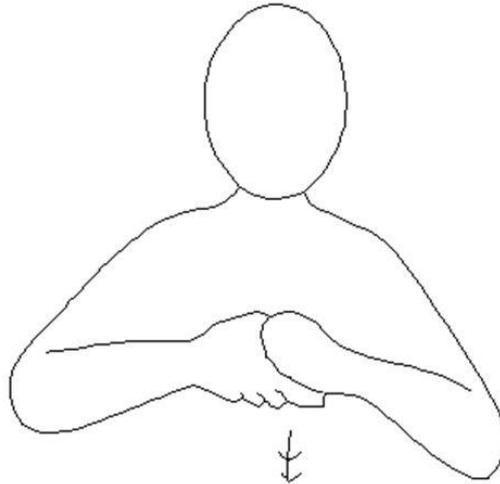
As of **Monday 17th January**, isolation time for someone who tests positive is 5 full 24 hour days but only if you have negative lateral flow tests on the morning of days 5 and 6. The first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period, and the second must be taken the following day. If not, you will need to continue to isolate until there are two consecutive days of negative lateral flow tests.

All test results should be reported to NHS Test and Trace.

If you are unable to do lateral flow tests you will need to isolate for the full 10 days.
