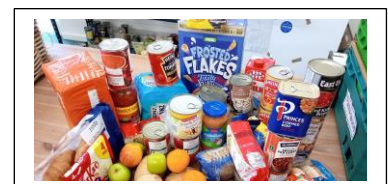


St Paul’s Pantry
