**Red warning**

Temperatures are set to rise up to 39C in London on Sunday, Monday and Tuesday. This level of heat can have adverse health effects on everyone. Please keep safe by making sure children are well hydrated, are wearing cool and loose-fitting clothing, are kept in the shade or indoors especially between 11am-3pm. Try to keep curtains or blinds closed by make sure that rooms are well ventilated. Avoid physical exertion, wear sun cream and a sun hat if outdoors. Be aware that water left out in paddling pools will heat up and if you're using a garden hose let it run for a while as the pipe will be hot.

If you intend to keep your child at home we will authorise this and send home learning activities to you. You can also choose to pick up your child earlier in the day to avoid going home on the hot bus, particularly, if they have a long journey. Please can you email Toni to indicate your intentions.

## Parents/Carers' Survey


Wandsworth Council is currently undertaking a procurement exercise for the Schools Catering Contract, with the new contract to start providing meals in schools from September 2023.
