Pluto class – **Noah** for great cutting and sticking and then matching the shapes

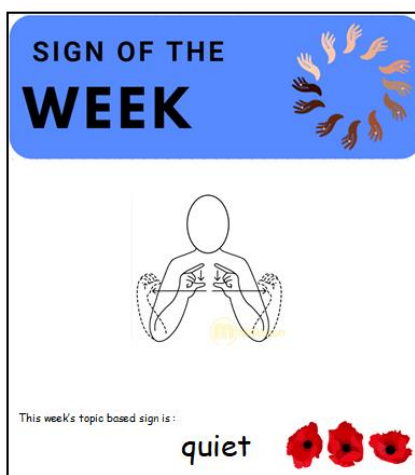
