Mars class – **Neriah** for amazing phonics work!

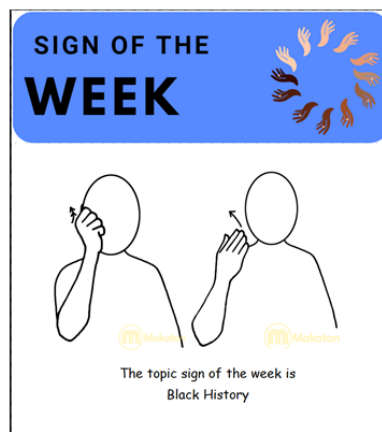
Pluto class – **Abdullahi** for great concentration during his math session
