**Pluto class - Noah** for being an absolute superstar with the photographer and posing like a true professional!

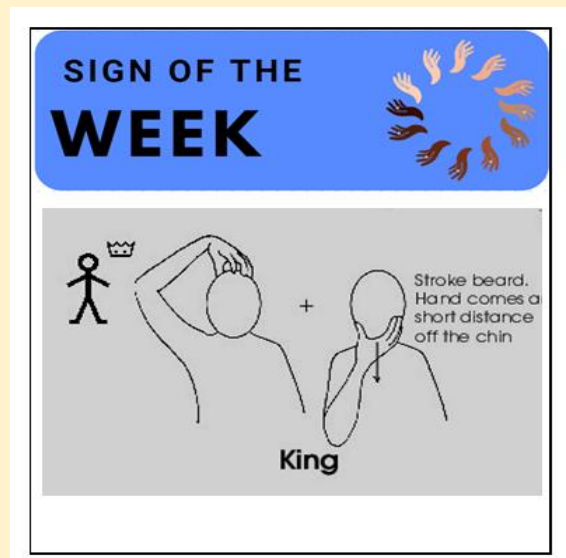
**Therapy - Ben** for being happy, calm, engaged and working really hard throughout his aquatic therapy session with help from SLT, OT and PT
